WHAT:

Eleven (11) top players from the local qualifiers held recently in Hawaii will advance to a thirty six-hole sectional qualifying event that will be held this Monday, June 7, 2004 at Turtle Bay Resort's Arnold Palmer Course.

The top finisher will advance to the 2004 U.S. Open Championship that will be played at Shinnecock Hills Golf Club, in Southampton, New York, from June 17 to 20, 2004.

This is the first time players are able to participate in the sectional qualifying in Hawaii. In previous years, local qualifiers from Hawaii traveled to the mainland to participate in sectional qualifying, in order to earn a spot and advance to the Championship.

Located on the North Shore of Oahu, the 880-acre Turtle Bay Resort recently completed a \$60 million renovation project that involved new greens and facility improvements to both courses, including a restored back nine on the Fazio course. Turtle Bay now offers a completely re-modeled pro shop, a scenic clubhouse restaurant, and a new, world-class practice facility located near the Palmer Course.

These players defeated 130 golfers in the local qualifiers that were held in Maui, Kauai and Oahu.
